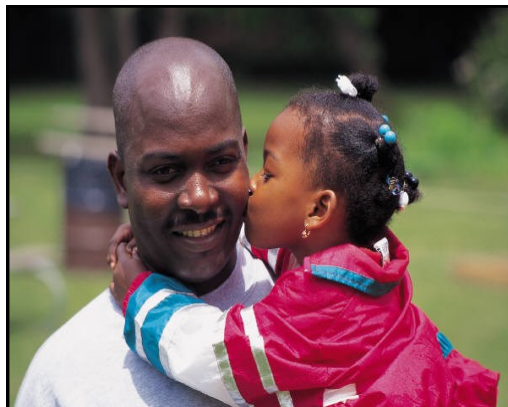


# Our Mission

## *Improving Life Through Quality Behavioral Healthcare Services*

**Grand Prairie Services** is a not-for-profit behavioral healthcare provider. The organization began in 1950 as a counseling agency in Park Forest, Illinois. Over the years and continuing today, Grand Prairie Services provides a comprehensive continuum of professional services. Our staff is comprised of the area's finest psychiatrists, psychologists, social workers and counselors who truly care about helping people improve the quality of their lives.

### **Accessible, Affordable**

We operate multiple community-based office centers so that you and your family can receive the services needed at a location that is convenient for you. Fees are based upon a person's ability to pay. Our professional services are available for everyone, regardless of their current economic situation.

### **Crisis Services**

Crisis intervention services are available for adults, children and adolescents 24-hours a day to respond to emergencies at any time of the day or night. Through our Screening Assessment and Support Services (SASS) Program, we conduct emergency evaluations of children at risk of psychiatric hospitalization in South Suburban Cook County.



### **Psychiatric Services**

Our psychiatrists are available to children, adolescents and adults for psychiatric evaluations, medication management and therapeutic services.

### **Counseling Services**

We provide a full range of individual, family, group counseling and care management services in a comfortable, caring atmosphere. Bilingual counselors are available. Every day we help the residents of our south suburban communicate deal with the challenges of depression, anxiety, individual or family crises, chronic illness and many other challenges.



### **Developmental Disability Training**

Skill development training for developmentally disabled individuals 18 years and older. Some of the skills included are medication management, economic self-sufficiency, motor development and pre-vocational/vocational training.

### **Residential Services**

For over twenty years, GPS has provided homes for individuals living with mental illnesses and developmental disabilities. Our Residential program is unique in that each individual's needs are considered when determining the type of residential environment. Our program has community integrated living with independent residences, shared residences and group homes where the level of supervision is based on the need of the individual.

### **Psychosocial Rehabilitation**

The purpose of our Psychosocial Rehabilitation Program is to provide individuals with the skills to lead independent lives and cope with the many facets of mental illnesses. The Intensive Stabilization Program assists in short-term crisis situations to avert hospitalization. The Skill Building Program focuses on understanding mental illness, symptom management and developing skills for community living situations. Pre-Vocational Services is designed to promote basic job seeking skills with the objective of transitioning into a meaningful work experience. The Drop-In Center provides a social and recreational opportunity for individuals to develop socialization skills and participate in activities in a safe, social environment.

### **Grief and Bereavement Services**

Special grief and bereavement services are available for individuals experiencing grief, bereavement or forced transition in their lives. Individual and group support services are available for those who have lost a spouse, children dealing with the loss or death of a friend or loved one, and to assist parents to understand a child's grief process and address their questions.
